

NVTerra - 2nd call for proposals nominee

Based in Monthey (VS), the spin-off NVTerra proposes to install a pilot water treatment unit based on filtration and electrolysis in Addah village in the Ivory Coast. The plant has a capacity of 100m3/day and will treat insalubrious water from a well, to be sold at affordable prices through village fountains and through ergonomic reusable cans in the neighborhood. The company's business model combines a market approach with participatory elements. It includes a joint venture with the local company ZEONVT as well as partnerships with Think Africa and DFH – Design for Humanity. Maintenance will be ensured with a remote control system.
